Need to create an exemption under TAPC3 for SSSA and SAHPA because A and C ratings are not both applicable in these cases.

The following must be added under privileges and limitations for Approved Persons.

≤600kg – group and category ratings

≤1200kg – group, category or type specific

≤5700kg – group and type specific

Discussion was held on the addition of W, X, P and S ratings. Under P ratings Cat I and Cat J will be moved to E rating.

RK made the comment that for the sake of conformity that TAP3 becomes TAP1 so that 1 always relates to the highest rating.
